INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF UNAUDITED INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MANGLOOR HIGHWAYS PRIVATE LIMITED

- We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Financial Results of MANGLOOR HIGHWAYS PRIVATE LIMITED ("the Company"), for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2023 ("the Statement") being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
- 2) This statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.

Notes to Unaudited Financial Results for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2023:

- 1 The above unaudited financial results of the Company for the quarter and six months September 30, 2023 were reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on November 07, 2023. The statutory auditors of the Company have carried out limited review of the unaudited financial results for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2023.
- The above unaudited financial results of the Company have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and the other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- The Company is engaged in the business of construction, operation and maintenance of Toll road projects on a Hybrid Annuity Model basis and thus operates in a single business segment. As such, all activities undertaken by the Company are incidental to the main business. Therefore, there are no separate reportable business segments as per IND AS 108 "Operating Segments".
- In the absence of distributable profits, the Company has not created Debenture Redemption Reserve (DRR) during the current period. The Company is regular in redeeming matured debentures.
- Pursuant to the Share Purchase Agreement ("SPA") executed between the Company, Dilip Buildcon Limited and Cube Highways and Infrastructure III Pte. Ltd. ("CH-III"), Dilip Buildcon Limited transferred the remaining 182,325 (51%) equity shares of the Company to Cube Highways and Infrastructure III Pte. Ltd. ("CH-III") on August 08, 2022. Consequently, the Company became wholly owned subsidiary of Cube Highways and Infrastructure III Pte. Ltd. ("CH-III").
- As at September 30, 2023, the Company is having negative net worth of Rs. 303.11 Lacs. The Company as such has positive net current assets position and adequate cash reserves for debenture service reserve account (DSRA) in accordance with debenture trust deed. Further, based on the future assured cash flows in form of annuities as per the Concession Agreement with NHAI, projected future cash outflows and projected profits during the balance concession period, the Company will be able to meet all its present and future liabilities. Accordingly, based on the above factors no material uncertainty exists with respect to the Company continuing as a going concern.
- 7 The Company has outstanding secured Series A and Series B non-convertible debentures amounting to Rs. 26,911.05 Lacs as at September 30, 2023. The asset cover is 1.17 times as at September 30, 2023.
- 8 The Code on Social Security, 2020 has been notified in the Official Gazette on September 29, 2020. The effective date from which the changes are applicable is yet to be notified and the rules are yet to be framed. Impact if any of the change will be assessed and accounted in the period in which said code becomes effective and the rules formed thereunder are published.
- 9 The Ind AS financial results of the Company for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2022 and for the year ended March 31, 2023 were reviewed/audited by the predecessor auditor, who have expressed an unmodified review conclusion / audit opinion.
- Since the Company does not have any managing director/executive director, the above financials results have been signed by non-executive director, as per authorisation of the Board of Directors of the Company.
